# Practical Information

## - TRAVELLING TO KOTOR -

### BY PLANE

Kotor is conveniently located just 5km from Tivat Airport (TIV), from which you can take a taxi for approximately 15 €. Alternatively, you can also fly to the nearby Podgorica Airport (TGD, 90km away), or Dubrovnik Airport (DBV, 70km away) and take one of the busses (or rent-a-car) to Kotor.

### BY BUS/TRAIN

There's no train station in Kotor, yet train lovers often travel to nearby Podgorica or Bar, from which you can easily reach Kotor in 1,5h-2h by bus for only a few euros. There are also many international buses from neighbouring countries which are particularly frequent during summer season.

## - ACCOMMODATION IN KOTOR -

### STUDENTS DORMITORY "SPASIC-MASERA"

Students will be accommodated in double/triple rooms in the Students Dormitory "Spasic Masera", just a few minutes walk from the beach, and 15-min walk to the Old town and the Faculty of tourism and hotel management.
